Short description of product	The IANUS partnership has created this handbook in order to indicate formats, contents, targets, methods and values to be applied in education in later life. Education in later life is not just about the transmission of knowledge, but also about jointly creating new knowledge. Learning and education in later life is education for life – a principle which needs to be mirrored in every course programme or agenda. Consequently one of the specific focuses of this handbook is on the didactic aspects of education in later life; on how to meet the heterogeneous interests of heterogeneous study groups of older people, in different learning settings, primarily in intergenerational, intercultural, and ICT-based settings. In these settings various aspects of learning in later life are promoted, with the intergenerational setting emerging as being of particular significance. The marginalised social position of older people will not be improved and eradicated if they are regarded as a separate and isolated group in society. The guidelines are based on the belief that the generational and cultural characteristics of older (and younger generations) must be taken into account when designing, organising and delivering educational and training programmes for older people or for mixed-generation target groups.
